

Kannad's warranty is 24 months from date of installation or thirty months from date of M/U. Actual warranty states:

"The equipment is warranted against all material or manufacturing defect for a period of two years from the date of installation on the aircraft or thirty months for the date of shipment from KANNAD [...] whichever occur first."

Many Kannad ELT's were installed 24 months ago so if you have not had the aircraft back for the 24 month ELT inspection, may I suggest you ensure that the warranty period (potential) is still available to you. If you have been regularly testing your Kannad ELT via the RC200, a potential claim for low power output will not be an issue.

We have had a few Kannad AF-Compacts replaced under warranty by having low power output; however we have not had a G Switch failure ☺

Note also that batteries must be replaced if they have had one hour's operation (activation time). This needs to be the operator responsibility or the maintenance engineer to check as there have been a number of incidents that have not seen the ELT back to us for battery replacement yet.
