

Worksafe and the new Health & Safety regime is front of mind for many of us as the new HSE regulations take shape. High profile recent prosecutions brought by [Worksafe](#) and uncertainty over how the new rules will impact operators is understandably causing some nervousness amongst industry as to what the future holds. So, let me hopefully provide some reassurance. There is currently an MOU in place between CAA and Dept of Labour (as was) which explains where the CAA HSE jurisdiction starts and ends [here](#). The CAA's HSE unit assures me that this MOU is expected to remain in force with Worksafe – so this is a good starting point. More useful information is on the CAA main H&S page [here](#).

We will have Worksafe and CAA at Aviation Leadership Week, so there will be a good opportunity to ask questions and raise any issues in person.

We have also negotiated 20% discount for Aviation NZ members to an online simple to use HSE compliance tool developed by a former ag pilot – so someone who understands the industry. Duncan is also very happy to talk you through how to use it etc [here](#).

Still concerned? Please [email](#) any queries and we'll pick them up with both regulators.

Robinson Helicopter Fleet


