
Effective Date: 01/12/17

The following information **must be** recorded for every **aerial applied** agrichemical application. This comes into effect on the 1st December 2017 and is required under both the Hazardous Substances (Hazardous Property Controls) Notice & Health and Safety at Work Hazardous Substances Regulations 2017.

These records must be kept for at least **3 years** after the date of the application.

1. Product trade name.
2. The HSNO approval number of the agrichemicals used (found on the SDS, Label, Haznote or Product Safety card).
3. Date of the application.
4. Time of the application.
5. Amount of the agrichemical(s) used.
6. The name of the users and the users address.
7. Location of where the agrichemical was applied.
8. Wind speed & wind direction where the agrichemical was applied.
9. Other measures taken to ensure there are no significant adverse effects beyond the boundary of the application area.
10. In relation to organophosphates or carbamate insecticides, details of measures taken to ensure there are no adverse effects beyond the boundary of the subject property into an adjoining property or into a sensitive area.
11. Electronic data files that indicate locations of where the agrichemical has been dispensed and aircraft secondary positional information (for example, geographic information system original shape files, based on Global Navigation Satellite System data).
